3. I attach hereto marked "**BN1**" a copy of my record of service, as captured by TEBA Limited.

4. As a team member, my job duties included collecting rocks to put place in the path of the scraper and igniting the dynamite that would be used to clear rocks.

5. During my time working for Harmony, I was frequently and regularly exposed to silica dust released during day-to-day mining activities. This exposure occurred from working with and near activities such as drilling, blasting, and crushing of ore and rock.

6. The dust levels underground were generally controlled by spraying the walls with water. This was done once in the morning, and after each blast that occurred during a shift. Blasting underground created a lot of dust and much of it remained in the workspace, even after the walls were sprayed with water, as we could still see it, as well as taste and smell it. There was no ventilation to control the dust levels in my workspace underground and, as a result, the watering process was the only means of dust control. The dust would remain in the air until the walls were watered, and soon thereafter, when walls dried, the dust levels would increase again. The watering process was an ineffective means of controlling the dust levels underground.

7. On a daily basis, I and my co-workers breathed silica dust in the following areas of the mines: in the travelling tunnels and in the worksite.

8. I was never provided with any respiratory equipment. I inhaled all dust that I was exposed to.

9. The dust levels were especially high when I would enter the mine at the beginning of my shift. I had to walk eight kilometres through the tunnels underground to get to my workspace. Lots of dust would settle on the equipment that we used and the equipment was not cleaned during or between shifts. The dust would also settle on our hair, face, and clothes while we worked.
10. Prior to being permitted to work on the gold mines, I was medically tested for the presence of occupational lung diseases, including silicosis, and was deemed to be well and fit to work underground. Thereafter, I was examined periodically for the presence of silicosis and other occupational lung diseases.
11. I was diagnosed to be suffering from TB and Pneumoconiosis during my Exit Medical Examination conducted by my former employer in 1997 (see attached certificate marked "BN2"). As a result of this diagnosis, I was retrenched. I was 52 years old at the time.
12. In June 2012, I was diagnosed with silicosis. I attach the medical report confirming the diagnosis marked "BN3". I did not have silicosis prior to working on the gold mines.
13. When I walk up stairs I experience sharp pains in my lungs and I have to take frequent breaks when walking. I get exhausted from walking which makes doing everyday activities very difficult. I have to be careful to not overexert myself

because there is much work that needs to be done and I need to have the energy to do it.

14. As a result of having silicosis, I am no longer able to work. The government pension that I receive does not cover my expenses. I have one wife, four children, and two grandchildren that are my dependants. They require food, clothing, and education. In months when either I or one of my dependants needs to visit a hospital, it becomes especially challenging to cover the monthly costs.

15. I have accordingly suffered the following damages:

15.1 loss of earnings;

15.2 medical expenses;

15.3 general damages for pain, suffering, loss of amenities of life, disablement and reduced life expectancy.

16. I, along with thousands of other mineworkers, have contracted silicosis as a result of our employment with Respondents' mines. I am committed to vigorously prosecuting this litigation on my own and my fellow mineworkers' behalf. I intend to obtain the largest recovery for the class consistent with good faith and sound judgment.

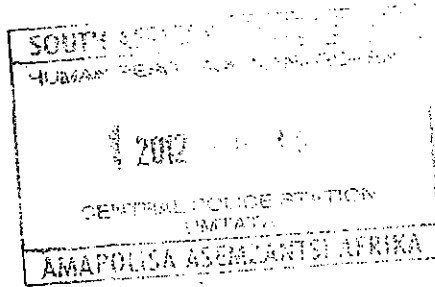

4. As a team leader and a boss boy, my duties were to supervise the other mineworkers underground. As a miner, I was responsible for blasting underground.
5. During my time working for these mining companies, I was frequently and regularly exposed to silica dust released during day-to-day mining activities. This exposure occurred from working with and near activities such as blasting, crushing and transporting rock and ore.
6. On a daily basis, I and my co-workers breathed silica dust in the following areas of the mines: the stopes and the development tunnels where blasting took place, as well as at the tipping station. There was often poor ventilation in the tunnels, which, in addition to the dusty environments in which I worked, made it difficult to breathe underground.
7. The positions that I held underground meant that I was often close to areas where blasting took place. Any explosion underground created large amounts of dust, to which I was exposed, and I could see taste and smell dust. When explosions took place in other levels of the mine during a shift, it would create dust in my workspace as well, as the walls of the tunnels reverberated with the blast. After completing each shift underground, my uniform was covered in dust.



8. Prior to being permitted to work on the gold mines, I was medically tested for the presence of occupational lung diseases, including silicosis, and was deemed to be well and fit to work underground. Thereafter, I was examined periodically for the presence of silicosis and other occupational lung diseases.

9. In 2004, I was certified to be suffering from silicosis by the Medical Bureau for Occupational Diseases (MBOD). I attach hereto marked "SP2" a copy of the MBOD certificate issued to me. As a result of having silicosis, my former employer found that I was no longer able to perform my duties underground and my employment on Elandsrand mine was terminated. I was 51 years old at the time. Attached marked "SP3" is a letter confirming my termination of employment on medical grounds. I did not have silicosis prior to working on the gold mines.



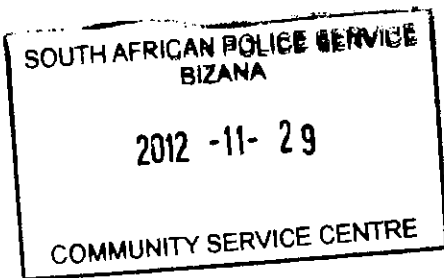

4. As a winch driver, my duty was to load the rock and ore into the loco carriages for it to be taken to the surface. As a loco driver, I was responsible for driving the gold that had been mined underground to the surface of the tunnels.

5. During my time working for these mining companies, I was frequently and regularly exposed to silica dust released during day-to-day mining activities. This exposure occurred from working with and near activities such as blasting, crushing and transporting rock and ore.
6. On a daily basis, I and my co-workers breathed silica dust in the following areas of the mines: in the tunnels where blasting took place, as well as at the tipping points, where the rock and ore was put into the loco carriages.
7. I could always see, taste and smell dust in my work space while I worked underground. My clothes and face were always covered in dust.
8. Prior to being permitted to work on the gold mines, I was medically tested for the presence of occupational lung diseases, including silicosis, and was deemed to be well and fit to work underground.
